The program houses the State Coordinating Office that employs subject matter experts in Floodplain Management to assist South Carolina communities, the Cooperating Technical Partners program that produces the Flood Insurance Rate Maps, and administers the Flood Mitigation Assistance grant program that provides grants to communities to minimize future flood losses.
